




I hope this is helpful.

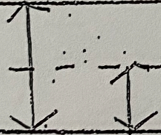

Capital letters are full space. They touch the top and sit on the bottom line. A is not  rounded or too wide . The middle cross line is made on the dotted line. a = "c" 1st and then a straight line down. (not a




B = a straight line 1st then a "3" - no loops ex 
b = a straight line 1st then a backwards c.


